Cleaning Guidelines For Rental Property Owners

- 1. Bathrooms and kitchens sanitized. Check shower curtain liners for cleaning or replacement. Check refrigerators, drawers and shelves, etc.
- 2. Microwave, coffee maker, toaster oven, and small appliances cleaned.
- 3. Excess items removed from drawers, refrigerators, cabinets, and from under beds & furniture.
- 4. All floors mopped, vacuumed, or otherwise cleaned.
- 5. All interior areas, including ceiling fans and A/C vents should be dusted, furniture wiped with cleaner, dryer vents and dryers checked for lint build up. Check washer and dryer for left behind clothes.
- 6. Windows and sliders cleaned when needed.
- 7. Check for light bulbs, batteries, trash bags, cleaning supplies at the house for tenant use, extra vacuum cleaner bags and belts, and other supplies.
- 8. Outdoor furniture should be cleaned, garage floor and outside showers swept/hosed and cleared of sand.
- 9. All trash and recycling removed from the property: Sea Isle City's Trash and Recycling Depot, located adjacent to the Sea Isle Bridge (JFK Boulevard and Kneass Street) is open seven (7) days a week 7:15am to 2:45pm.

<u>Note</u>: The Trash and Recycling Depot will be **closed** holidays (except: New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day).
