Kitchen:

- · Refrigerator cleaned and wiped out
- Counters wiped
- Microwave wiped out
- Coffee Maker cleaned out. Small appliances cleaned up.
- · Dishwasher emptied
- · Dishes, cups, pots, pans & silverware put away
- Trash cans emptied
- Floor swept

Bathrooms:

- · Toilet, sink and tub rinsed out
- Wipe off any fixture of noticeable or heavy dirt or debris
- Trash can emptied
- Floor swept

Bedrooms:

- Bedspreads and pillows placed on bed
- · Drawers checked for clothes...
- Check under beds
- Closets checked
- Floors swept or vacuumed
- Trash cans emptied

General:

- · All floors swept or vacuumed
- Trash recycled in proper containers
- · Trash removed and trash liners replaced
- Decks swept
- All inside and deck furniture properly arranged
- Sand swept out of garage and outside shower
- Clean off gas grill when finished using (while hot)
- Check to make sure you have your: cell phones, laptops, ipads, video games, and cables, chargers or extension cords for these items as well.
- Check to make sure you have any additional items you brought with you: ... pots, pans, prescription medication, beach chairs, electric griddle or frying pan, bikes, beach umbrella, coffee maker, walker...

Trash Removal : Summer curbside trash & recycling collections takes place twice a week from Memorial Day Monday thru the 3rd Monday in September.

As you go out JFK Blvd. towards the bridge, bear to the right (don't go over the bridge) as the dump is on the right at the end of the street by the bay.

If the property owner provided beach tags at the house for tenant use, please leave the beach tags in the house.
